LANGUAGE OF INSTRUCTION	ITALIAN: Recommended level B1 (CEFR) for courses taught in Italian. ENGLISH: MADE offers a limited number of courses in English. Recommended level: B2 (CEFR) At the BA level, courses are mainly taught in Italian, and exchange students are expected to have at least a basic proficiency in the language. However, we aim to avoid language as a barrier to applications. If students are not fluent, faculty will be informed and may provide support in English. Additionally, some elective modules are available in English, though their availability may vary each semester. At the MA level, the Design and Applied Crafts program is itinerant, taking place across various Mediterranean locations, and is taught entirely in English.

Received applications will be reviewed based on quality and availability. 5. If accepted, students must complete the Learning Agreement before the mobility. The course catalog is available on our website, but final availability of the courses may vary. *The portfolio must include related project materials with descriptions of the student's role and a brief critical analysis. It must be in PDF format, and any multimedia files should have open access via links (Vimeo or YouTube). For non-EU students: A copy of the Visa and Health Insurance is required before arrival.
